Company Hosts Annual Spirit of the Season Event for University Prep, Announces Local Foundation Grant Awards

TeleTech has hosted the Spirit of the Season holiday celebration, which this year benefitted University Prep students and families, for more than 13 years with participants enjoying a free and fun evening of entertainment, food, and gifts. 240 students and their families participated in the event, with more than 100 TeleTech employees volunteering for over 100 cumulative hours to plan, prepare and participate in the festivities. In addition, area Boy Scouts, middle school and high schools students volunteered and earned service hours while participating alongside TeleTech in the event. TeleTech is engaged in a multi-year partnership with University Prep and provides additional funding and support for a variety of technology and human capital needs at the school annually.
